Today, more than 95% of the graduates of this school enter higher education institutions. The students of this school are the ones who bring the most medals from the International Olympiads. People from all over the country, even from the capital Tashkent, take their children to Karakol and send them to this school. Given the great achievements of this educational institution, last year we turned it into the International School of Mathematics. Teacher Tokhtamurod, like our Jadid ancestors, worked tirelessly and selflessly to create a new school of modern methods. Here is the true enlightener of today, the Avloni of our time, the teacher of Behbudi, the Enlightened One! To achieve such a huge result, of course, there must be a unique training system.
